COMMITTEE REPORTS

Building

It has been a very busy year for building and renovations in MBA. I want to thank my fellow committee members, Mark Reilly and Alvin Ross, for their work and support through the year. At the close of the construction year on June 30, there were six construction projects put on hold until after Labor Day. This is really unusual for MBA. There was a lot of emergency work over the summer, largely roofs and other structural issues caused by the unusual weather and heavy rains. These will resume after Labor Day and new projects will begin then too. We have two large projects that are waiting approvals now and others expected. We urge you to reach out to us when you are in the planning stages of a project as this can ease and streamline the details of your projects. Trash/Recycling Enclosures

In 2020, community members urged the Board to begin the process of improving the appearance and effectiveness of existing trash enclosures and the presence of recycling bins which stayed on the streets for months at a time. In 2021, the Board put together an ad-hoc Trash Enclosure committee which evaluated the situation and made recommendations for revised Trash Rules. These recommendations went to the Ad Hoc Rules Committee in January 2022. The MBA Board approved revised Trash/Recycling Rules in March 2022. In October 2022, there were 96 non-compliant trash and/or recycling enclosures and the Board issued notices to these properties that after December 31, 2022, it would begin enforcing the revised Trash/Recycling Rules. MBA residential properties which receive MBA-provided trash and recycling services must have a compliant trash and recycling enclosure to house trash and recycling bins.
