Brush & other yard debris MUST be placed in paper bags or tied in bundles no more than 4' long. These bags/bundles must be placed by the side of the road. Yard waste placed in plastic bags will NOT be picked up. Bags with yard waste must NOT contain any other trash. Yard waste may not be placed on community property more than two (2) weeks prior to any next scheduled pick up.

Trash Pickup Details & Guidelines

When a regularly scheduled trash or recycling pickup falls on a holiday, the pick up may take place the next day.

Republic Services offers Single-Stream recycling of regular household paper, glass, cans, etc.

Delaware Law prohibits ANY brush or lawn debris from being mixed with regular household trash. MBA has contracted for removal of brush or lawn debris. Please NOTE that Republic WILL NOT EMPTY trash cans that CONTAIN ANY LAWN or BRUSH DEBRIS. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE for PROPERLY SEPARATING YOUR TRASH, and for INFORMING GUESTS and RENTERS of this POLICY.

Except for immediately prior to the Spring Bulk Yard Waste pickup, brush and other yard debris MUST be placed in paper bags or tied in bundles no more than 4' long. These bags or bundles of yard waste must be placed by the side of the road. Yard waste placed in plastic lawn bags will NOT be picked up. Lawn or brush debris must NOT contain any other trash.

Trash and Recycling Services

If a developed MBA residential property receives MBA-provided trash and recycling services, it must have a compliant trash and recycling enclosure. Each property may have up to two (2) enclosures. For details of the Trash Rules and enclosures, please see middlesexbeach.org/community/trash

Recycling

Please DO NOT remove Recycling bins from your enclosure to put them by the street for the Recycling pick up. The contractor will get these bins & return them to the enclosure. Annual Bulk Household Waste Pick Up

Friday, May 8

Almost any household waste will be picked up: broken furniture, mattresses, appliances, etc. Remove freon from appliances and remove doors from freezers & refrigerators. Remove gas & oil from lawnmowers. SOLIDIFY latex paint with kitty litter, sand or sawdust (can also dispose in regular trash). Place items curbside the night before (but no sooner) to ensure collection. This pick up WILL NOT pick up construction debris, automobile batteries, flammable/hazardous materials, oil/ petroleum products, oil based paint, rocks, bricks, concrete blocks, concrete, dirt, stumps, tires, yard waste, propane tanks; and a/c units, freezers, refrigerators containing CFC freon gas.

Annual Bulk Yard Waste Pick Up

Monday, May 11

Clark Tree comes through with a shredder. Piles of yard waste must be placed alongside the road no later than the evening before. Yard waste is fed into the shredder. Clark Tree employees will not enter onto your property to carry out yard waste. Tree trunks and large limbs are not accepted.
